

## MAJOR MUNICIPAL RESERVOIR SYSTEM STORAGE

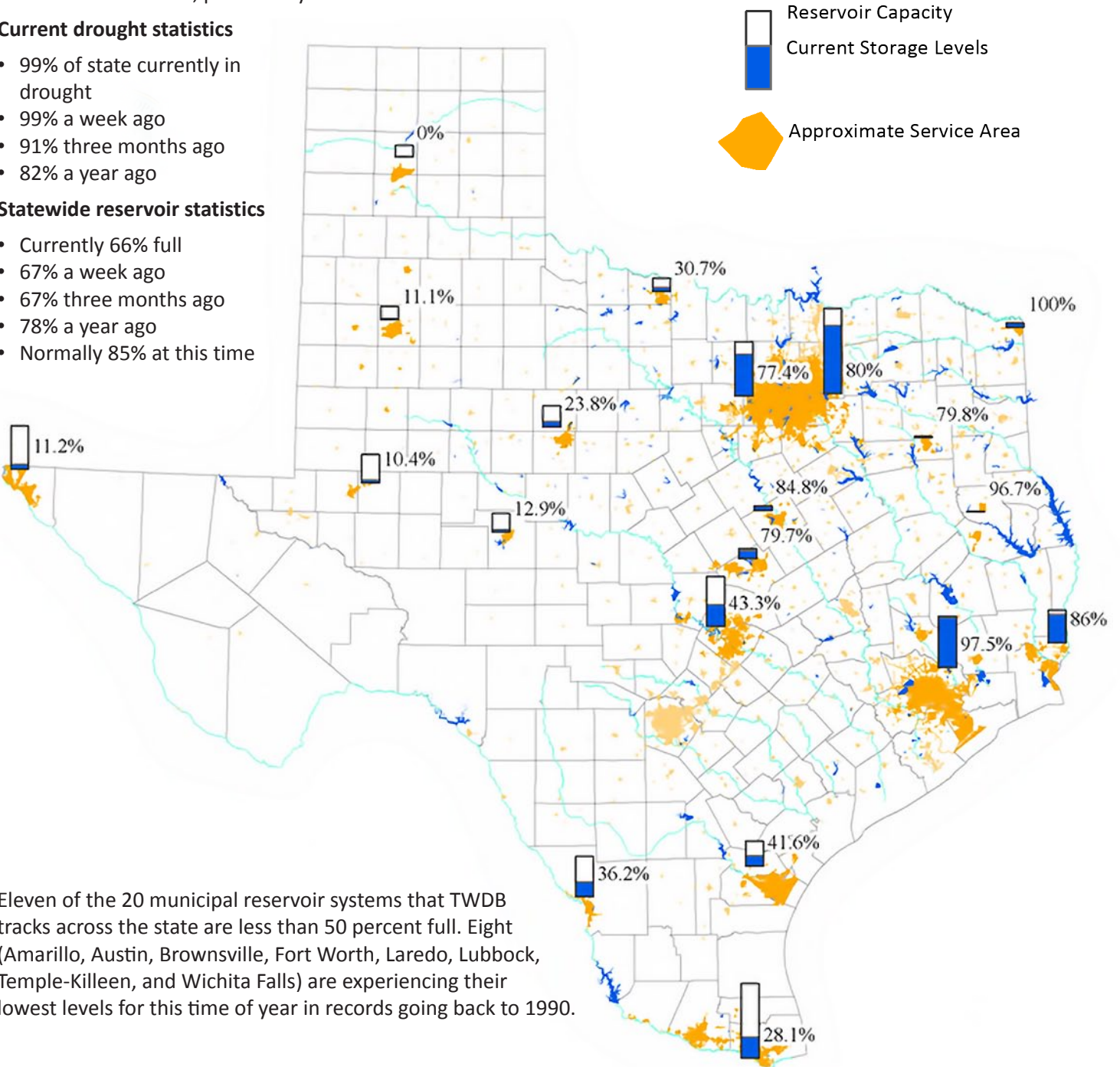
The drought continues. We'll see this week if the weekend rains, which covered much of the state, provided any benefit and relief to the state, particularly to South Texas.

### Current drought statistics

- 99% of state currently in drought
- 99% a week ago
- 91% three months ago
- 82% a year ago

### Statewide reservoir statistics

- Currently 66% full
- 67% a week ago
- 67% three months ago
- 78% a year ago
- Normally 85% at this time



Eleven of the 20 municipal reservoir systems that TWDB tracks across the state are less than 50 percent full. Eight (Amarillo, Austin, Brownsville, Fort Worth, Laredo, Lubbock, Temple-Killeen, and Wichita Falls) are experiencing their lowest levels for this time of year in records going back to 1990.
