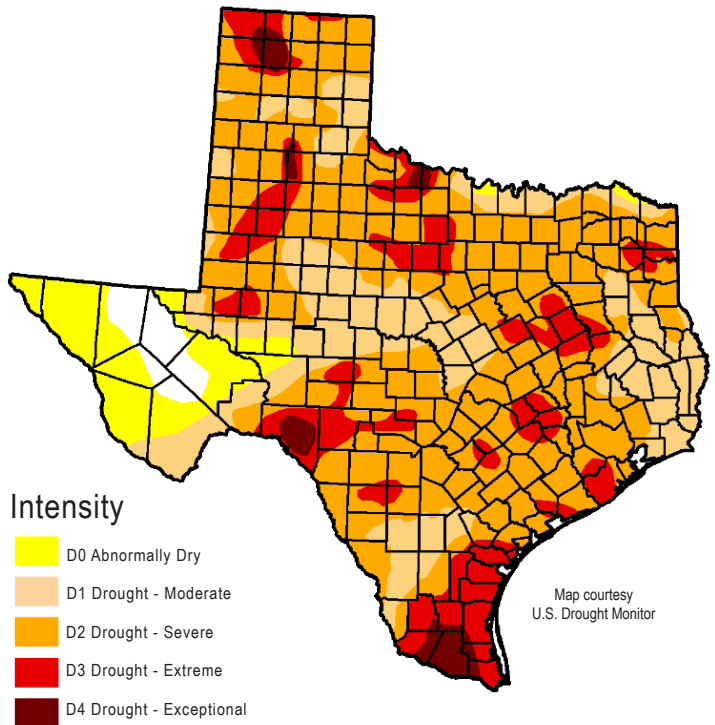


DROUGHT CONDITIONS

As we delve deeper into summer, we continue to see declines in statewide reservoir storage, although some parts of the state saw slight improvements. The latest Seasonal Drought Outlook, which looks into the crystal ball through November, is a mixed bag: Much of Far West Texas out of drought and some improvement in the Panhandle and north and east Texas but with continued drought in the rest of the state.

Drought statistics

- 97% of state currently in drought
- 97% a week ago
- 97% three months ago
- 89% a year ago

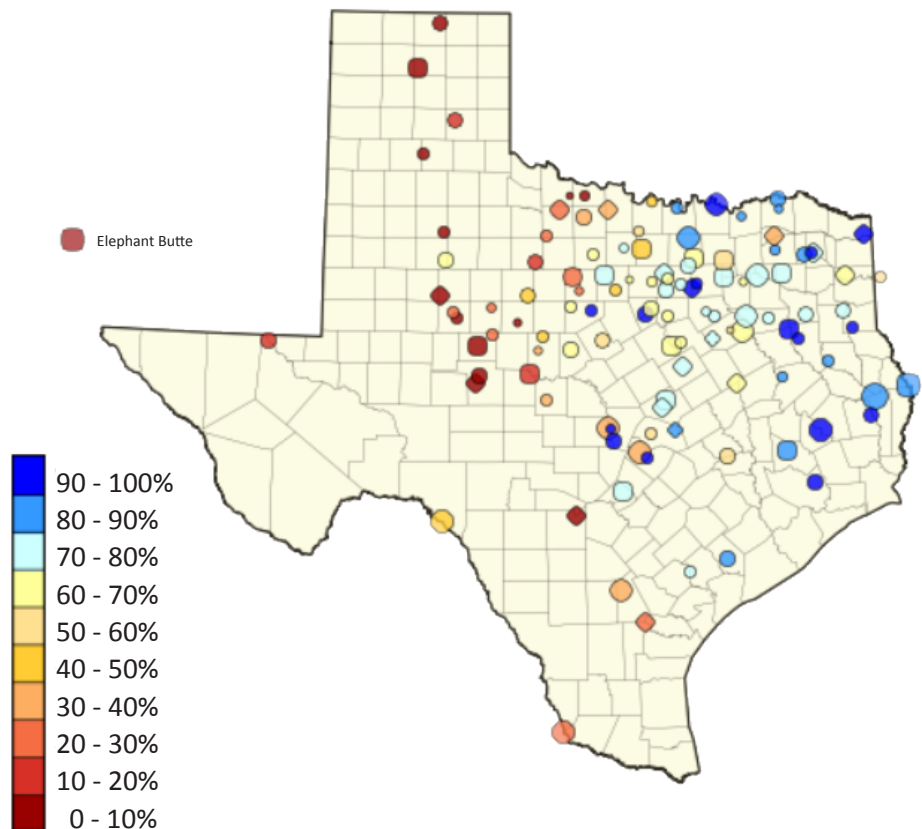


RESERVOIR CONDITIONS

Of the 119 reservoirs the TWDB tracks, 25 are less than 25 percent full, and 16 are below 10 percent.

Reservoir statistics

- Statewide: currently 61% full
- 62% a week ago
- 66% three months ago
- 70% a year ago
- Normally 82% at this time
