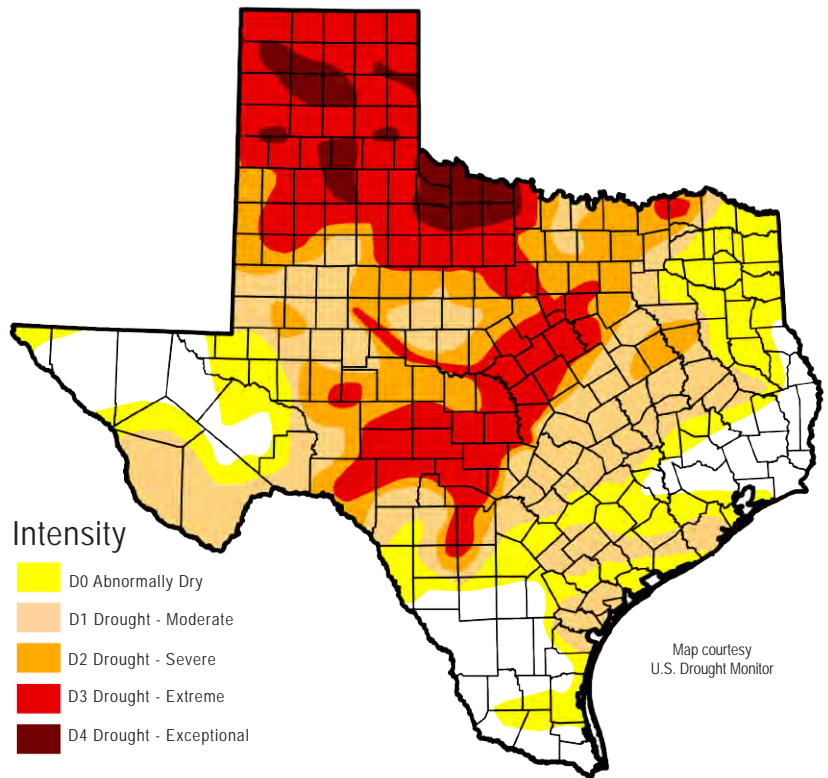


DROUGHT CONDITIONS

The past week saw worsening drought conditions in the Hill Country and Panhandle and slight improvements in East Texas. Overall storage in the state's reservoirs continues to be the lowest since 1990. Typically this time of year we would be seeing an increase in the amount of water in our reservoirs; thus far state-wide reservoir levels have been flat.

Drought statistics

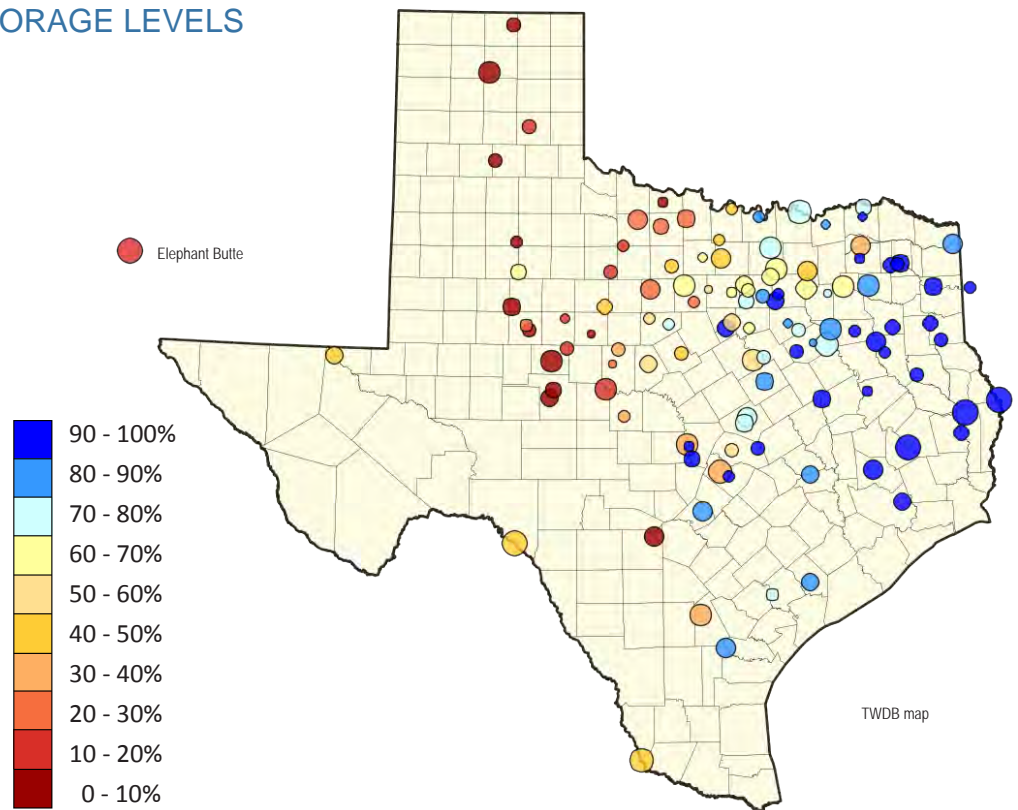
- 67% of state currently in moderate to exceptional drought
- 67% a week ago
- 44% three months ago
- 88% a year ago



STATEWIDE RESERVOIR STORAGE LEVELS

Monitored water supply reservoirs

- Currently 65% full
- 64% a week ago
- 64% three months ago
- 66% a year ago
- Normally 84% at this time
