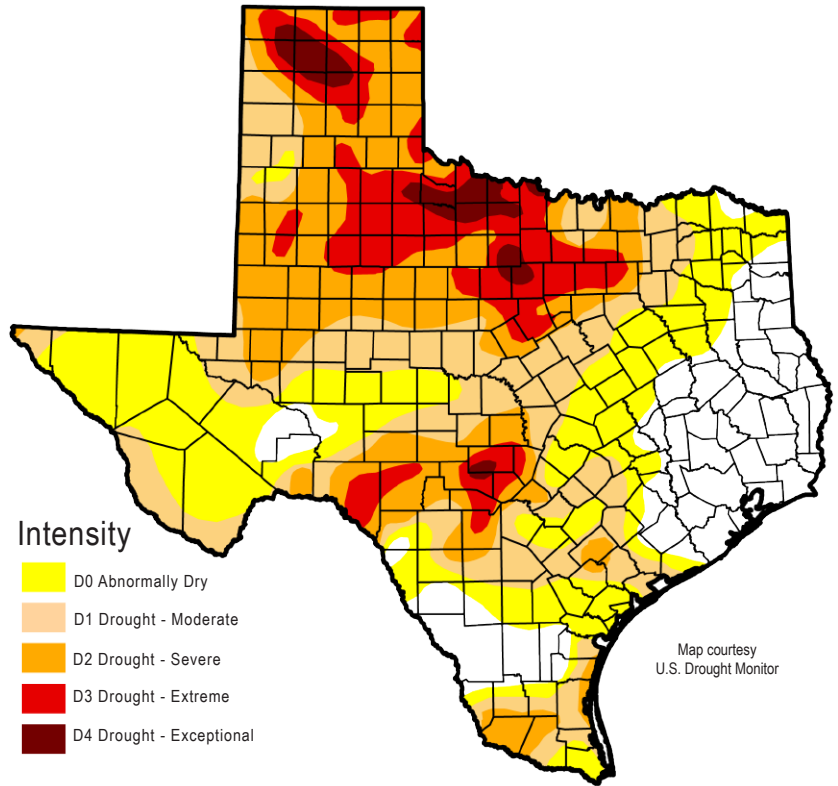


## DROUGHT CONDITIONS

Similar drought and reservoir conditions this week as last week; nevertheless, our reservoirs are about 66 percent full as compared to about 62 percent full last year at this time. In a bit of bad news for wetter weather this winter, the National Weather Service has downgraded the chances of El Niño this fall and winter from 80 percent to 65 percent.

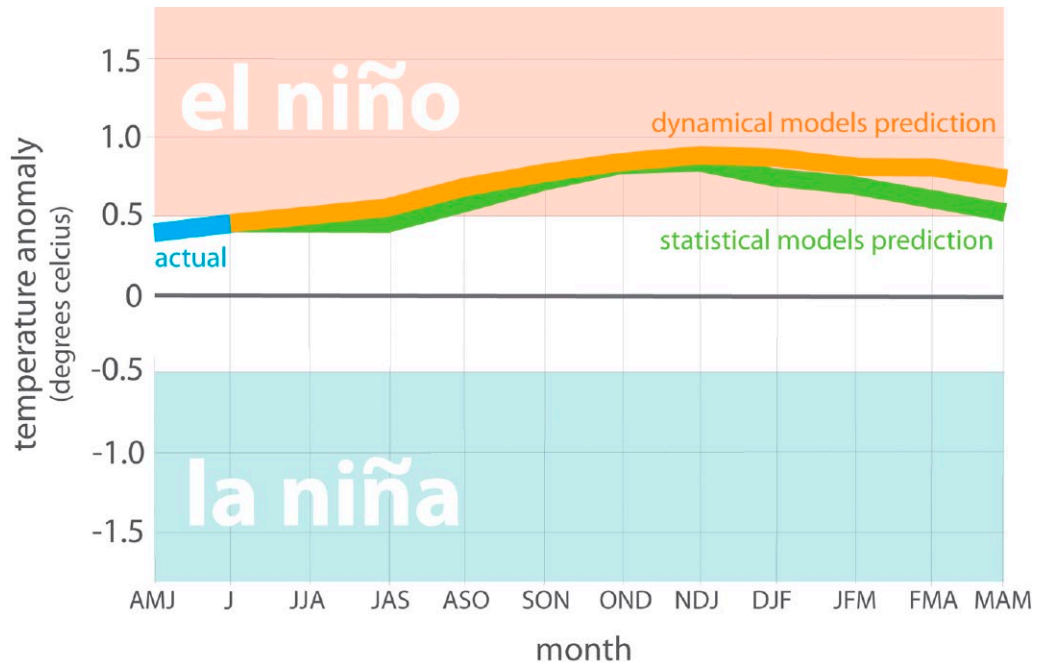
### Drought statistics

- 58% of state currently in moderate to exceptional drought
- 57% a week ago
- 73% three months ago
- 88% a year ago



## EL NIÑO

The National Weather Service updated its El Niño/Southern Oscillation Diagnostic Discussion on August 7th to state that “[t]he chance of El Niño has decreased to about 65%...”
