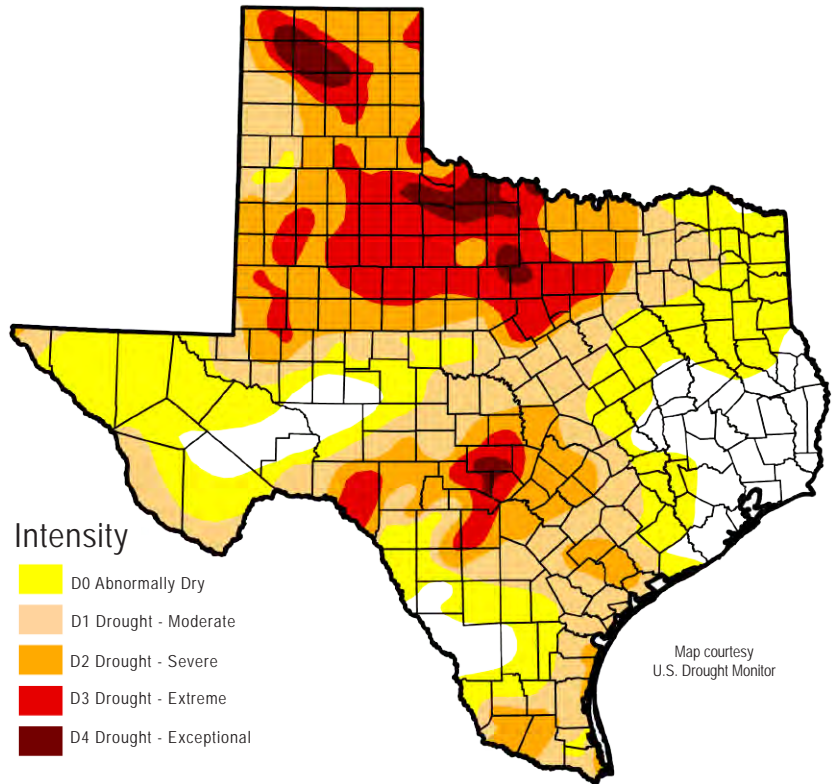


DROUGHT CONDITIONS

No changes in overall drought conditions over the past week, although statewide reservoir storage dropped by about 175,000 acre-feet (~0.6 percentage points), something that's normal during our typically hot and dry summer months. Drought conditions are expected to decrease in South Texas but continue in much of the rest of the state.

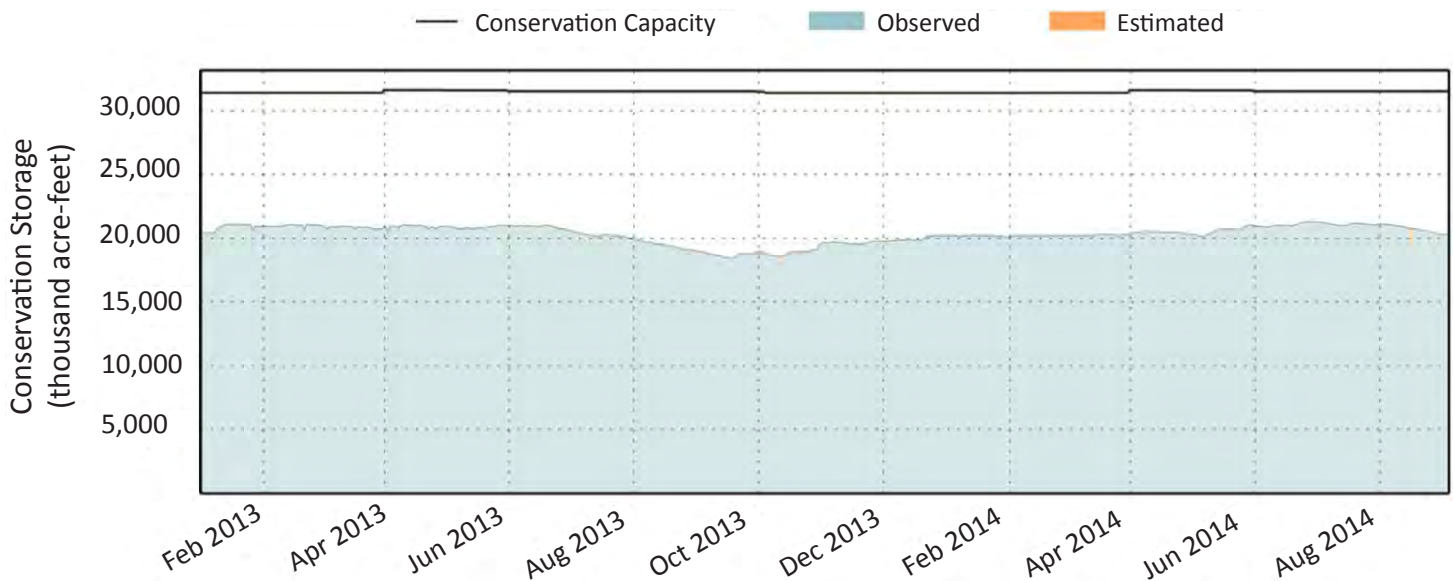
Drought statistics

- 61% of state currently in moderate to exceptional drought
- 61% a week ago
- 68% three months ago
- 87% a year ago



RESERVOIR LEVELS

This graph shows statewide reservoir storage (conservation storage) over the past 20 months. Despite recent declines, total reservoir storage has been relatively stable, although it remains 15 percentage points below normal.
