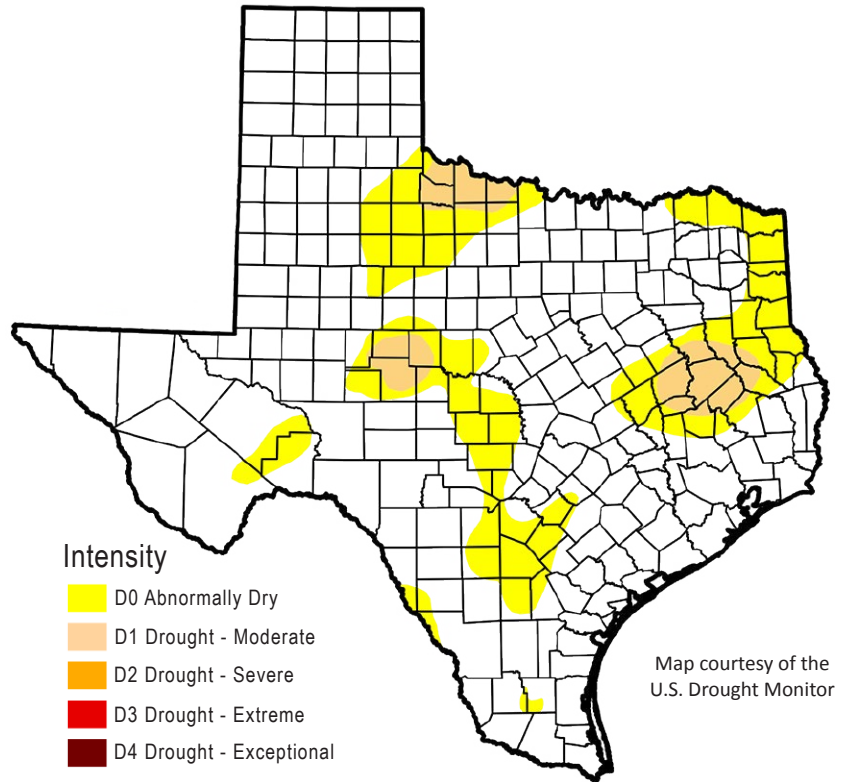


**WATER CONDITIONS**

Recent rains have now dampened drought to less than 5 percent of the state, with lingering areas of moderate drought near San Angelo, Wichita Falls, and Crockett. Statewide reservoir levels are up, although not as high as they were in July. Many reservoir levels in West and Far West Texas continue to be far below optimal levels.

**Drought conditions**

- 4% now
- 16% a week ago
- 5% three months ago
- 48% a year ago
