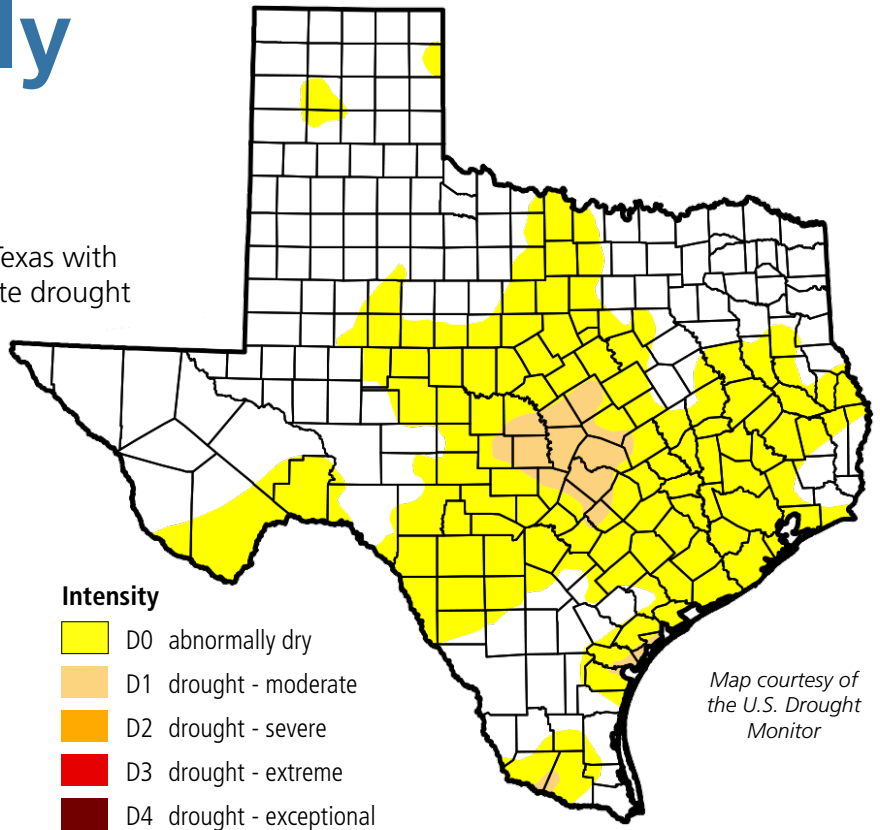

Water conditions

After an 11-week hiatus, drought is back in Texas with 4 percent of the state suffering from moderate drought conditions. Perhaps more alarming is the dramatic increase in abnormally dry conditions or worse growing from 12 percent of the state last week to 45 percent this week.

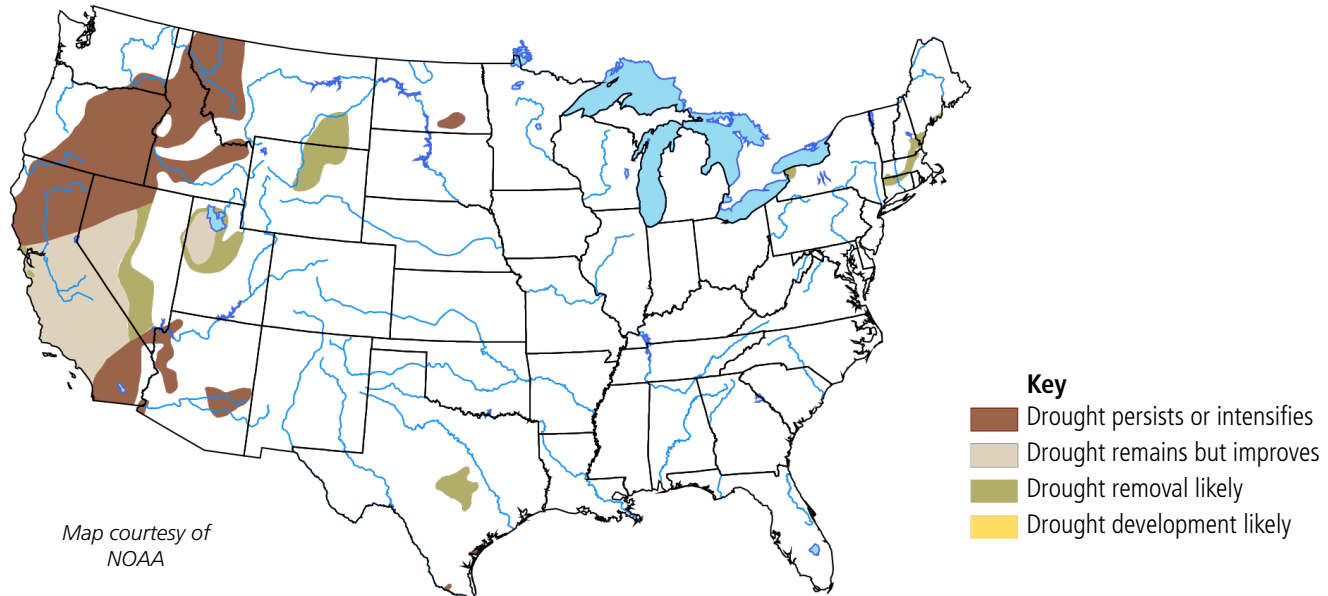
Drought conditions
