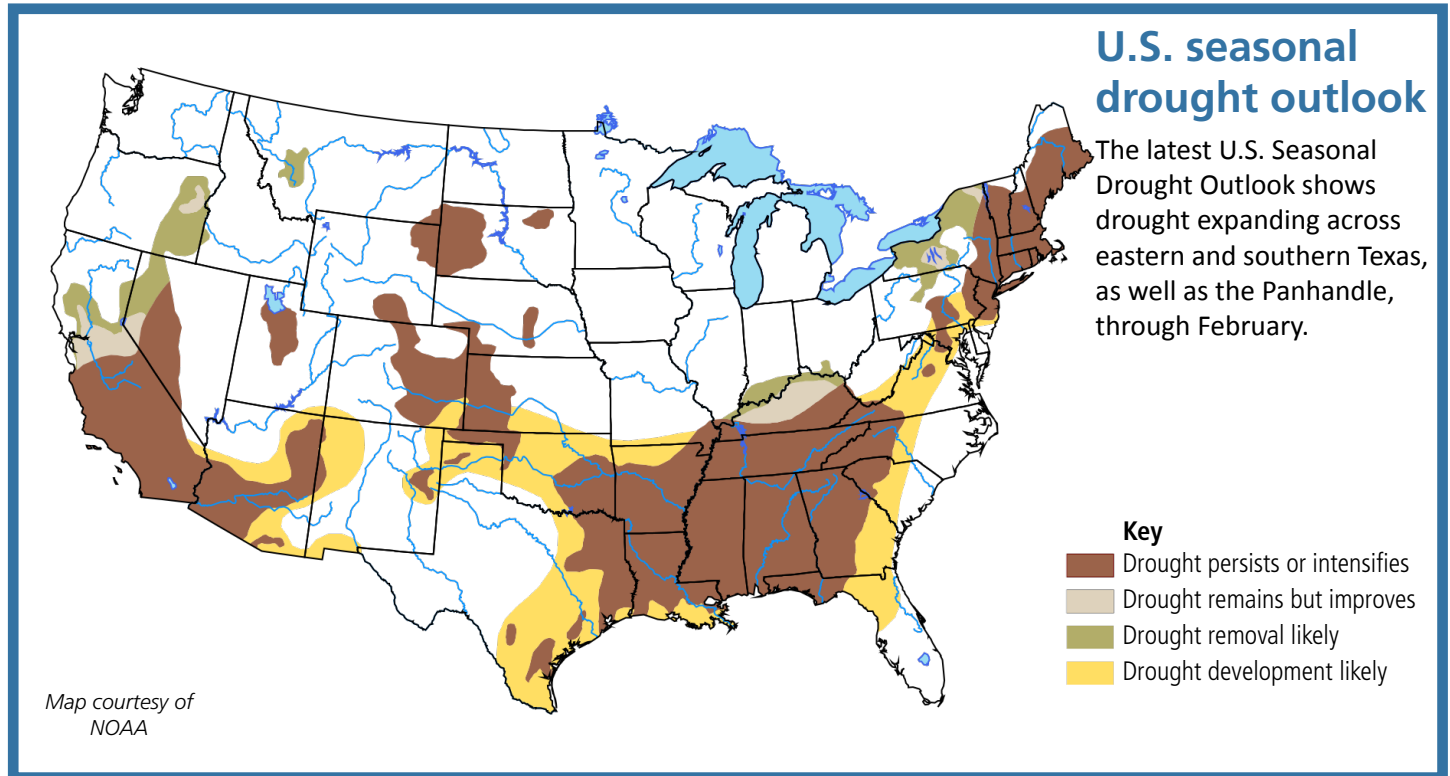
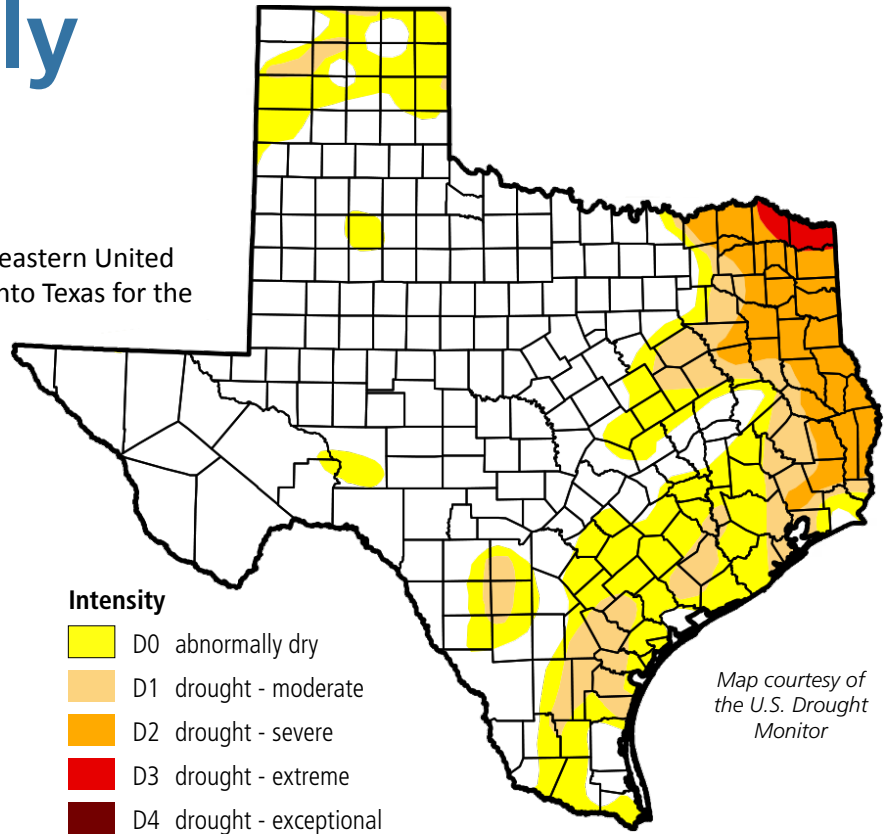

## Water conditions

The intensification of drought across the southeastern United States has brought severe drought conditions into Texas for the first time since October 2015. At our latitude, we are vised in with drought not only on the east but also on the west—and the vise is expected to tighten over the next several months.

## Drought conditions

- ◆ 16% now
- ◆ 14% a week ago
- ◆ 5% three months ago
- ◆ 0.6% a year ago
