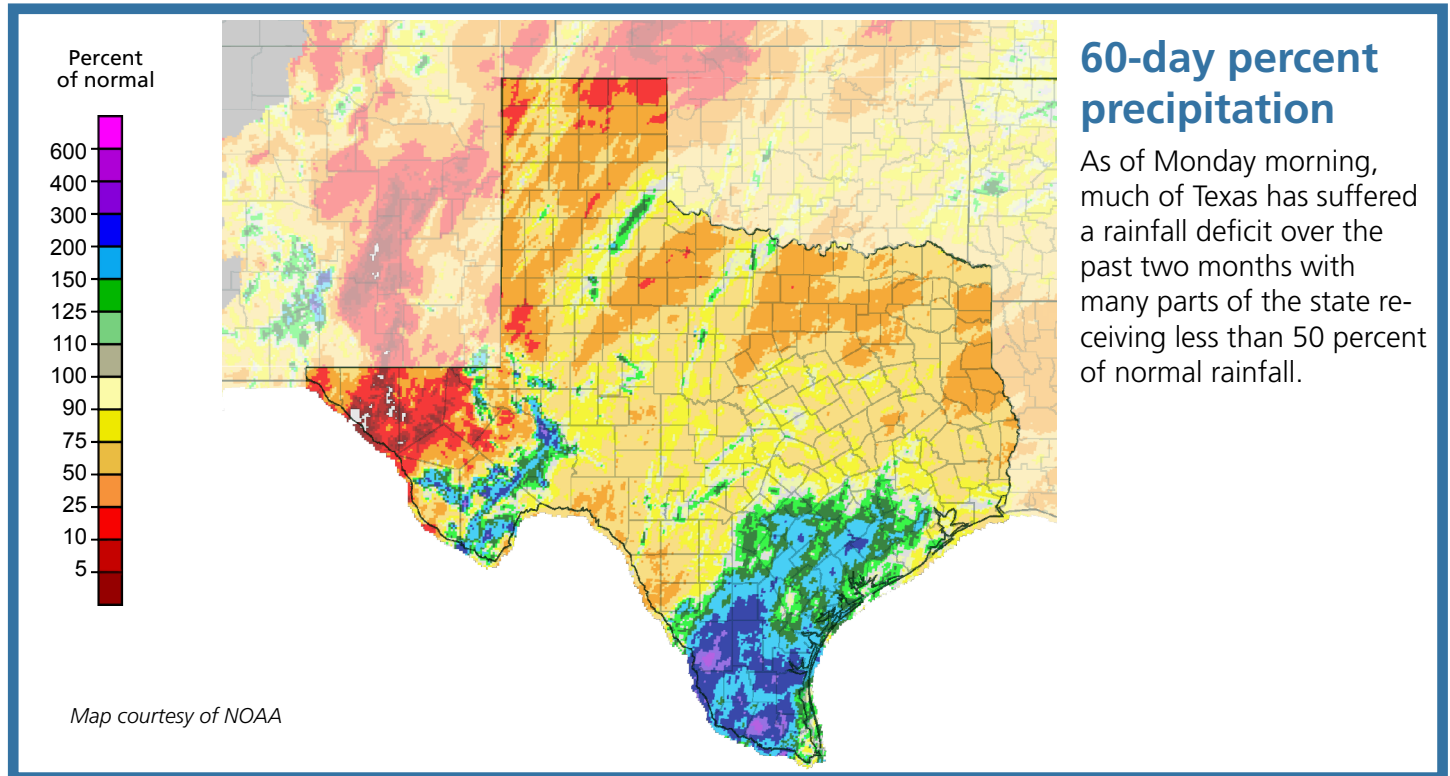
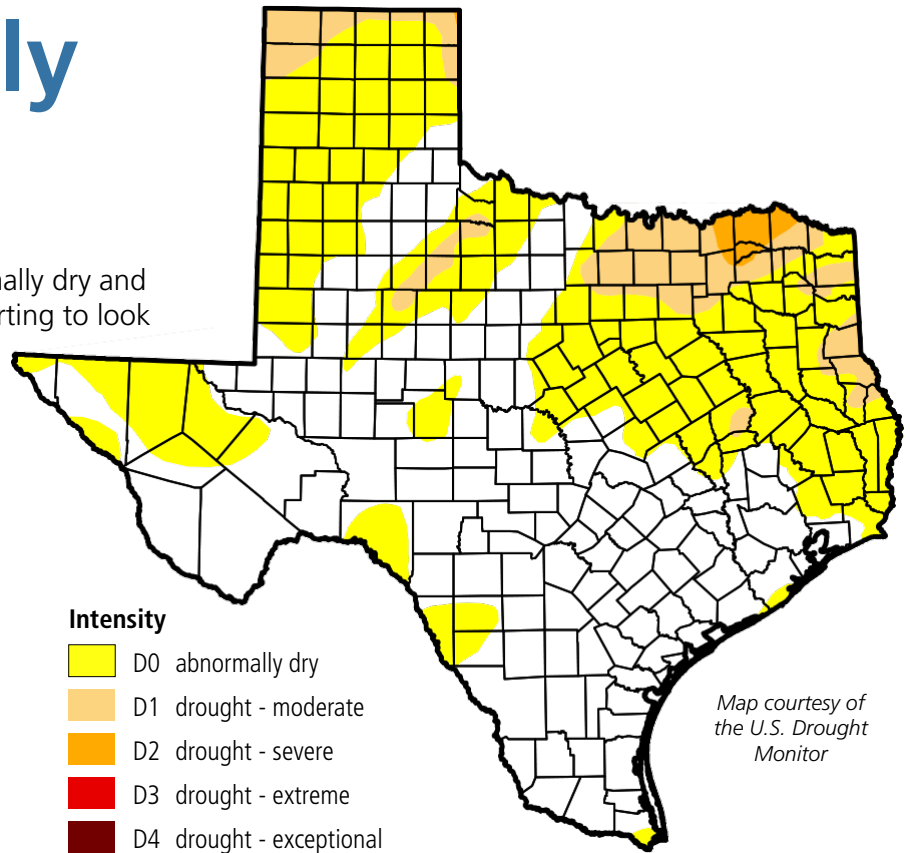

Water conditions

With 38 percent of the state at least abnormally dry and 8 percent officially in drought, things are starting to look quite drouthy around here. Late weekend storms with more expected this week should dampen the warm colors of the Drought Monitor in northeast Texas.

Drought conditions

- ◆ 8% now
- ◆ 5% a week ago
- ◆ 8% three months ago
- ◆ 0.7% a year ago

As of Monday morning, much of Texas has suffered a rainfall deficit over the past two months with many parts of the state receiving less than 50 percent of normal rainfall.
