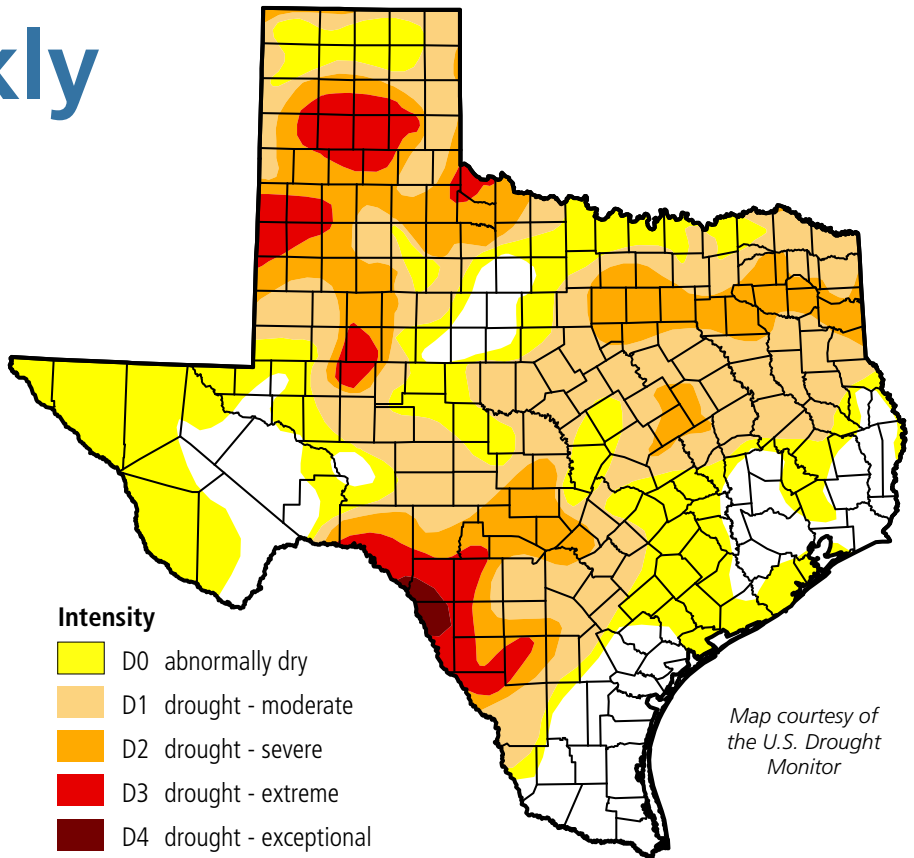

Water conditions

The latest drought map shows a 7 percentage point increase in the area of the state impacted by drought. Exceptional drought, which disappeared from the Panhandle last week, reemerged, this time near Del Rio. This map does not consider impacts of scattered rainfall since July 4.

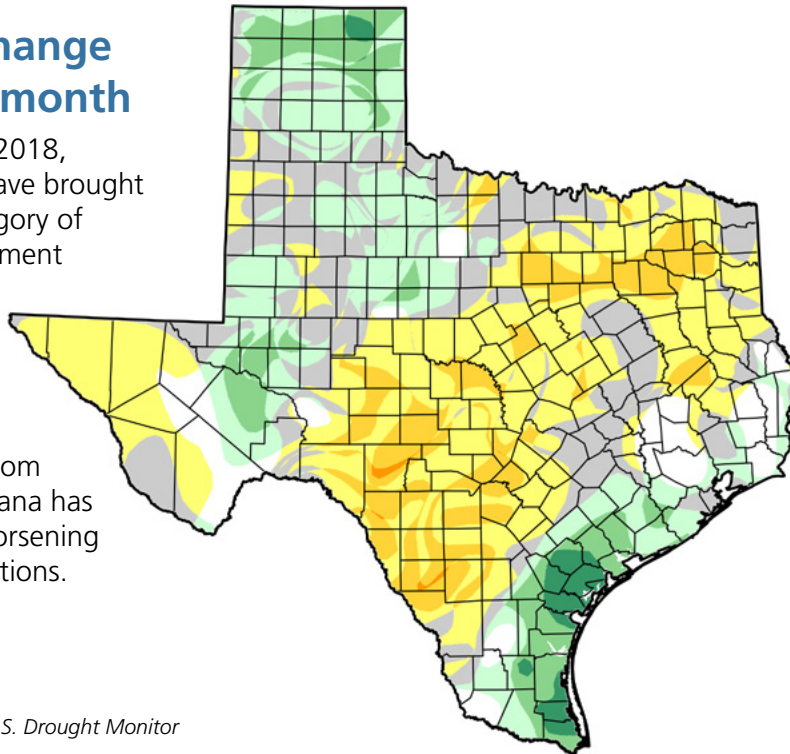


Drought conditions

- ◆ 55% now
- ◆ 48% a week ago
- ◆ 49% three months ago
- ◆ 6% a year ago

Drought change in the last month

Since early June 2018, scattered rains have brought at least one category of drought improvement to large areas of the Panhandle and Coastal Texas. However, a large area stretching from Del Rio to Texarkana has experienced a worsening of drought conditions.
