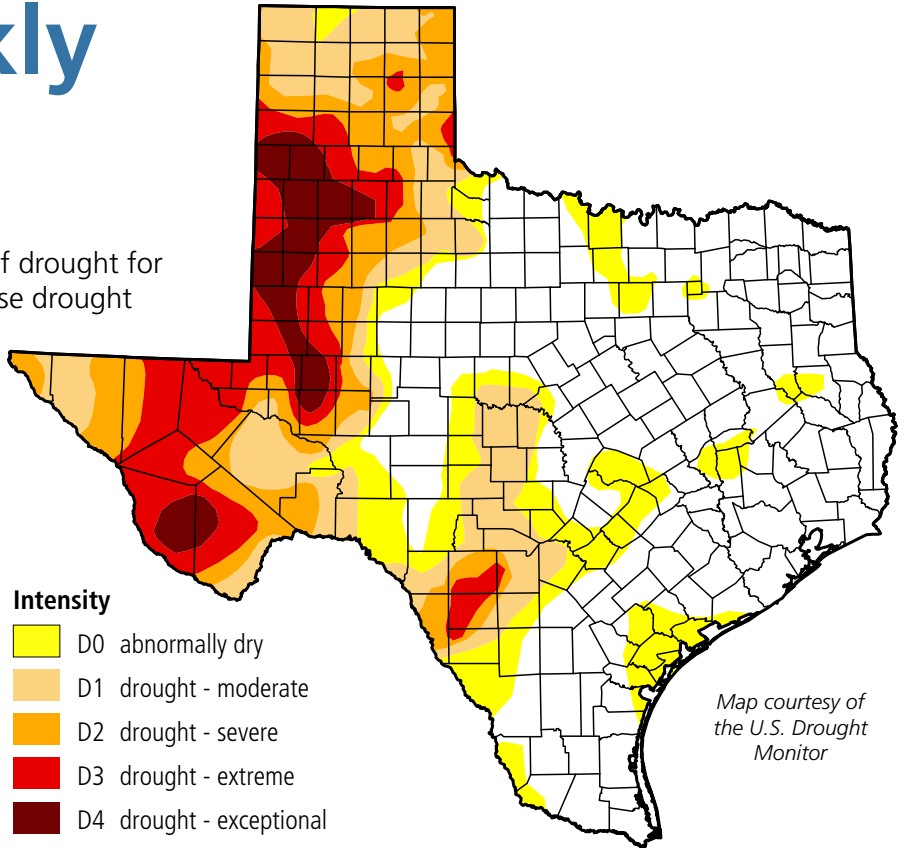

Water conditions

The latest drought map shows expansion of drought for the fourth straight week. Moderate or worse drought now impacts 40 percent of the state, similar to the start of September 2020. Exceptional drought is now impacting almost 5 percent of the state, its largest area since October 2015.

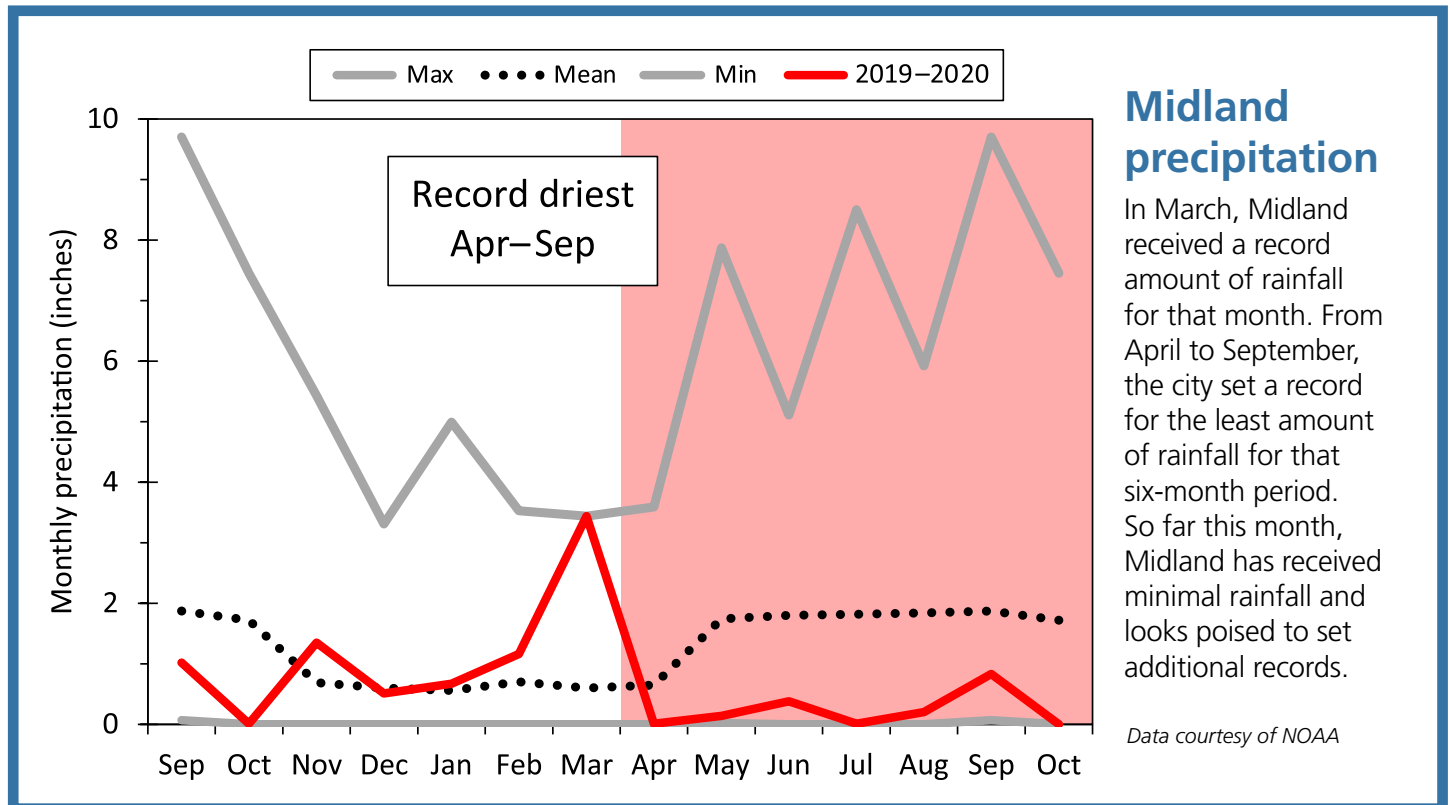


Drought conditions

- ◆ 40% now
- ◆ 36% a week ago
- ◆ 36% three months ago
- ◆ 49% a year ago

Intensity

- ◆ D0 abnormally dry
- ◆ D1 drought - moderate
- ◆ D2 drought - severe
- ◆ D3 drought - extreme
- ◆ D4 drought - exceptional
