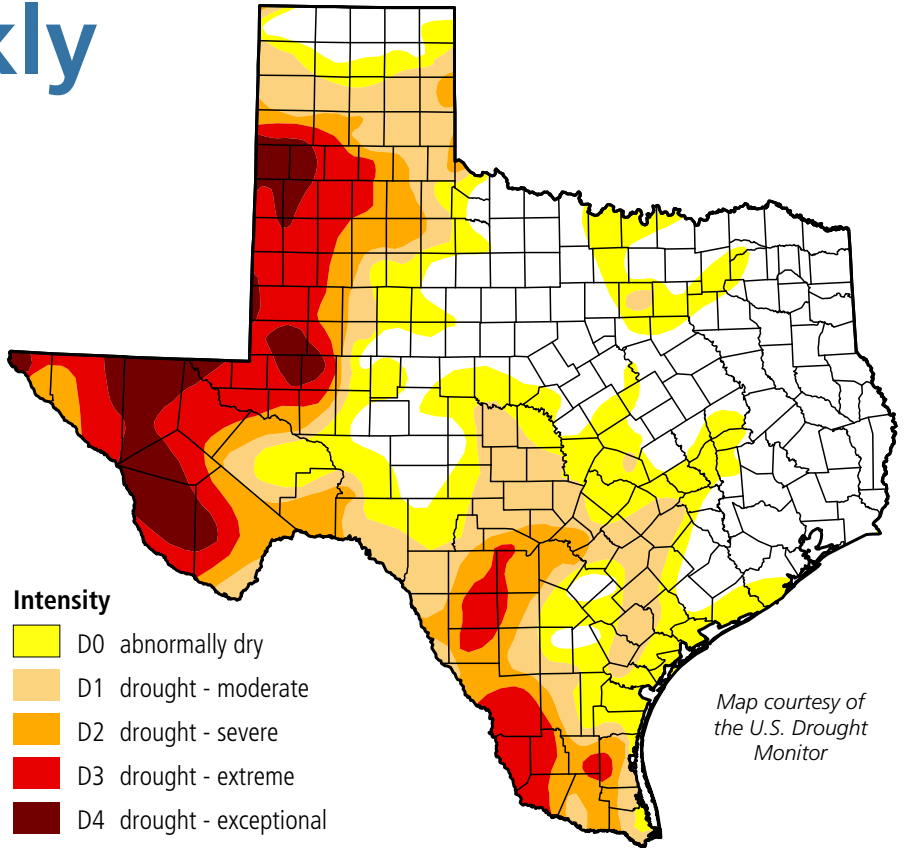


# Water Weekly

## Water conditions

The latest drought map for conditions as of February 2 shows improvement in Central Texas but degradation along the coast and in the Panhandle. Overall, there was a small increase in the total area of the state in drought. Changes to next week's map are also expected to be modest.

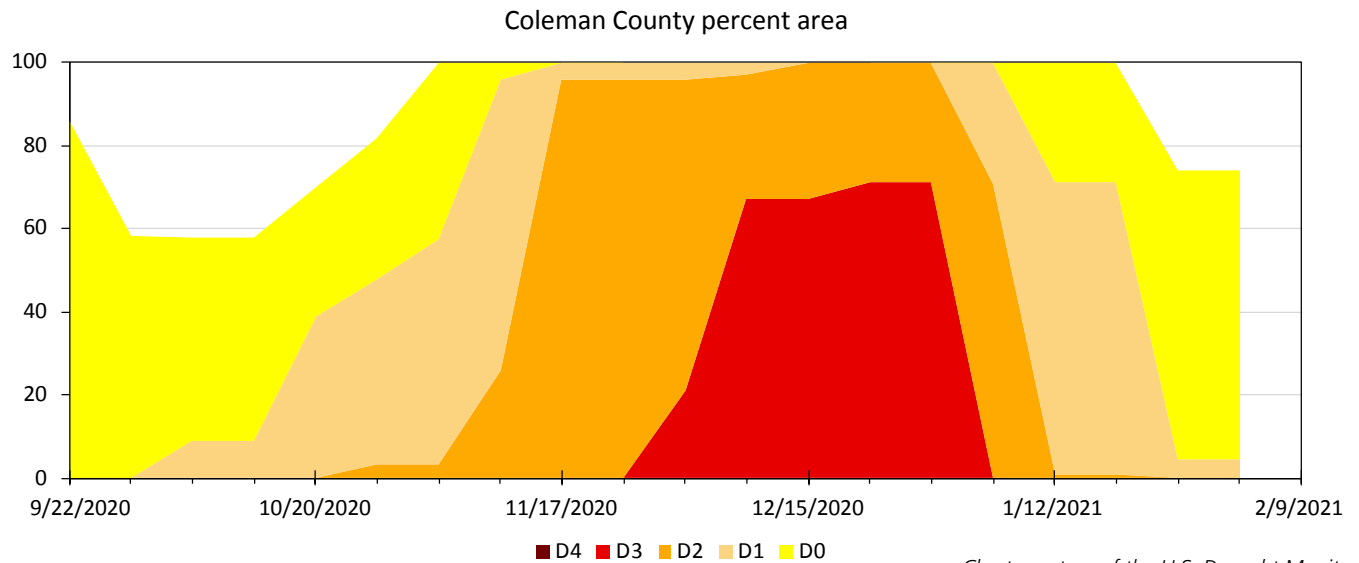


## Drought conditions

- ◆ 45% now
- ◆ 44% a week ago
- ◆ 46% three months ago
- ◆ 33% a year ago

## Coleman County percent area

Coleman County was essentially drought free at the end of September 2020, but drought rapidly expanded to cover the county by mid-November. Like other parts of Central Texas, Coleman County saw significant improvements during the first weeks of 2021. Currently, less than 5 percent of the county remains in drought.
