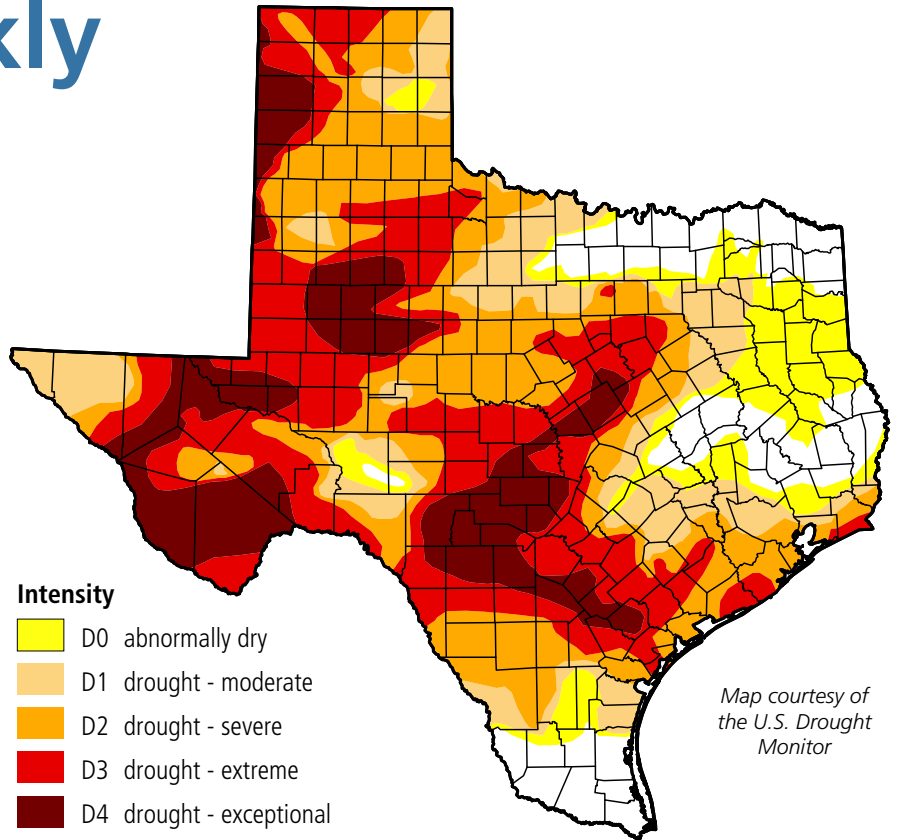


# Water Weekly

## Water conditions

The latest drought map for conditions as of June 7 shows a slight decrease in the area impacted by moderate to worse drought conditions compared to the end of May. Notable improvements were seen in northern Brewster, Tom Green, and Concho counties thanks to recent rainfall.



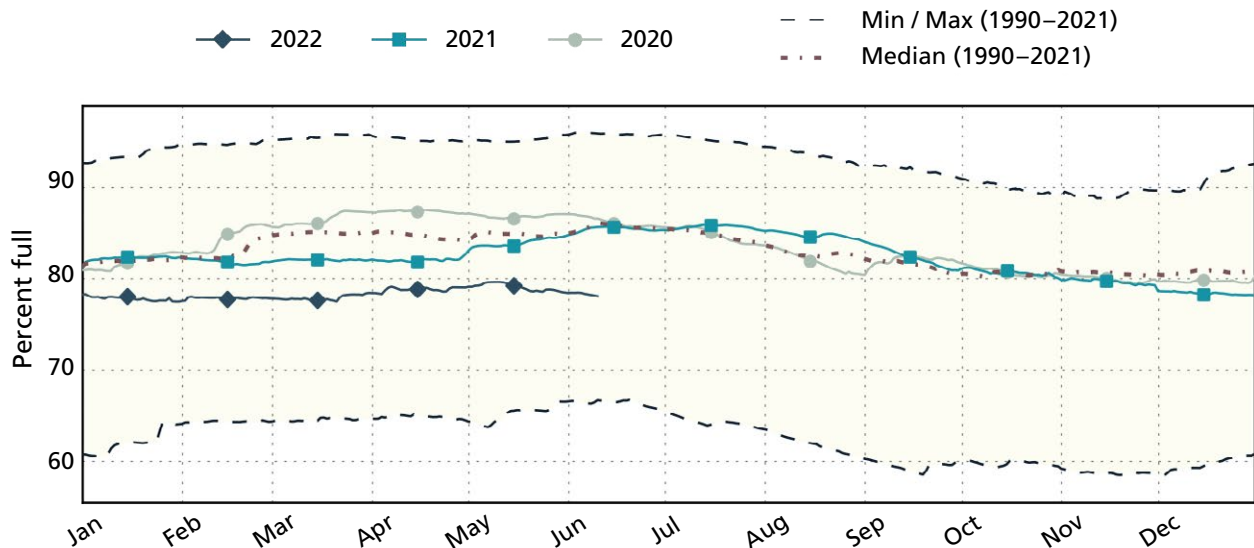
## Drought conditions

- 79% now
- 78% a week ago
- 90% three months ago
- 13% a year ago

## Statewide reservoir storage

TWDB chart

From May through June, statewide reservoir storage has been at 78.1 percent of conservation capacity. This is eight percentage points below what we have historically observed for this time of year. Similar statewide storage for this time of year was last recorded in May 2012 and June 2006.
